### **THE POSTION:**

Stege Sanitary District is seeking a Collection System Worker (1). This position will report to the Collections System Maintenance Superintendent. Duties include preventative sewer maintenance of the sewage collections system as part of a team. The position requires a valid Class B California Driver's License with airbrake and tanker endorsement.

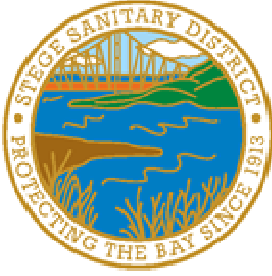

Typical duties include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Perform a variety of preventative sewer maintenance activities on the sewage collection system utilizing heavy equipment and power tools including a sewer rodder, sewer vacuum system and video inspection unit
- Inspect, test and maintain sewage pump stations
- Read and interpret sewer system maps
- Set up traffic control devices
- Continuous heavy labor and the ability to lift 80-100lbs
- Steep climbing and continuous walking, bending and crouching/kneeling
- Being on standby after normal business hours and weekends for a minimum of 7 days per month

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

**Experience:** Two (2) years of total experience performing maintenance work, preferably in a sewage collection system utilizing heavy equipment and power tools.

**Education:** High School diploma or equivalent.

**Licenses and Certifications:** Valid California class "B" drivers license with airbrake and tanker endorsement in compliance with Stege driving standards. A maintenance Grade I certificate issued by the California Water Environment Association (CWEA) is required within a 1-year period or two testing dates from the date of employment.

**Selection Procedure:** Applicants interested in applying for this position must submit a completed District application with and current DMV driving history printout. A resume may be attached but is not a substitute for a completed application. Responses of "See resume" will **not** be considered. A screening committee will evaluate the qualifications of each candidate who has met the minimum requirements for this position. The most qualified candidates will be invited to participate in the examination process. Applicants meeting the minimum qualifications are not guaranteed advancement to the examination process and the decision of the screening committee is final. All applicants will be notified of the results. Successful candidate(s) must pass a pre-employment physical and drug testing to be considered for appointment.
